LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

OF

I, Grace A. Taylor, being of full age, sound and disposing mind and memory and under no restraint, do make, declare and publish this to be my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all other Wills by me heretofore made.

ITEM 1: It is my will that all of my just debts be paid as soon as convenient after my decease.

ITEM 2: I give and bequeath to my niece, Helen Irene Thomas, my diamond ring that came to me from my mother, the same to be hers absolutely.

ITEM 3: I give and bequeath to my nephew, Charles M. Thomas and my niece, Helen Irene Thomas, the following pieces of furniture; 1 walnut straight chair; 2 walnut cane bottom chairs; 1 walnut spool leg table; 1 cherry drop leaf table; 1 walnut wash stand; 1 walnut desk; and 1 small maple table, to be divided as they see fit.

ITEM 4: I give and bequeath to my nephew, Charles M. Thomas and my niece, Helen Irene Thomas, the sum of \$500.00 each the same to be theirs absolutely.

ITEM 5: All the rest and residue of my property of whatsoever kind and wheresoever found, I give, devise and bequeath to my husband, James S. Taylor, the same to be his absolutely, if he be living at the time of my decease, if he should not be living at the time of my decease, or in the event of the death of my husband and myself in a common casualty, or under such circumstances that the order in which our deaths occur can not be readily determindd, then such provision for my husband shall lapse, and he shall not be deemed to have survived me, and I give, devise and bequeath all said rest and residue of my property to my nephew, Charles M. Thomas and my niece, Helen Irene Thomas, the same to be theirs absolutely.

ITEM 6: I hereby nominate and appoint my husband, James S. Taylor as Executor of this my Will and request the court to appoint him as such without bond, if he be living at the time of my decease, if he should not be living, then I nominate and appoint Holmes H. Kress as such Executor and request the court to appoint him as such.
