The Will of Ann Wyburn of Creech S<sup>t</sup>.  
Michael near Taunton, wife of Job Wyburn, now  
living in America but a native of Creech S<sup>t</sup>.  
Michael, aforesaid. I direct that from the  
time of my decease my Executors of this my  
Will shall become possessed of my household  
goods, money, debts due to me and securities for  
money (except as hereinafter mentioned) to pay  
my lawful debts, funeral and testamentary  
expenses and the surplus, if any to be given to  
George Wyburn the son of my late daughter  
Mary Wyburn. I give to my son James Wyburn  
so long as his father the aforesaid Job Wyburn  
and himself shall both live all my interest  
in property at North-end, Creech S<sup>t</sup>. Michael,  
near Taunton, secured to me by a certain Deed  
of Assignment dated the 12<sup>th</sup> August 1870. And  
from the decease either of Job Wyburn my  
husband or of James Wyburn my son I give  
the said interest and benefit secured to me  
by the said Deed equally to all my children

living at the time of my decease. I appoint  
my brother James Minson and my friend  
Mr. Edward Perris (in whose house I am now  
living) as Executors of this my Will written  
on two sheets of paper the first being signed  
by me at the foot thereof And I declare this  
to be my last Will and Testament and hereby  
revoke all former Wills which I may have  
made. Ann Wyburn. Signed by the said  
Testator as her last Will and Testament in  
the presence of us present at the same time  
who at her request have herunto signed our  
names as witnesses thereto in the presence of  
the said Testator and in the presence of each  
other this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of September 1881. ce  
Ann Minson. Charlotte Ann Minson.

Proved at Taunton the 10<sup>th</sup> day of October  
1887 by the Oaths of James Minson, the  
brother of the deceased, and Edward Perris,  
the Executors, to whom Administration  
was granted.
